

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for any of the plan(s) below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)

- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Core (HMO)
- Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Connect (PPO)

If you get extra help and enrolled the Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Secure in your monthly plan premium will be \$40.40. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Core, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Access, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Connect, Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska MA Secure premiums include coverage for both medical services and prescription drug coverage.
